Sustainability Policy

1 RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES

This policy is approved by the Company's Board of Directors. The Board holds ultimate responsibility for the Group's sustainability strategy, performance, and policy commitments. The CEO is accountable for implementing and monitoring the policy's effectiveness across the Group. Sustainability reporting and performance is overseen by the CFO.

The VP of Sustainability leads the development, implementation, and review of the Group's sustainability strategy, ensuring alignment with objectives and regulatory standards. Senior management integrates its related sustainability targets into operations, risk management, and performance evaluation.

Managers must provide employees and contractors with the training and resources needed to meet the Group's sustainability standards. All employees and representatives are responsible for upholding and promoting this policy's commitments.

2 ESG FOCUS AREAS

- **Environmental Care**: The Group is committed to minimizing the environmental impact of our operations, with a focus on greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, pollution of air and sea, resource use and waste management. Operations shall be conducted according to sound and environmental principles and in a manner to minimise any adverse environmental impact.
- People & Safety: Our greatest asset is our people. Their safety, well-being, and development is our
 priority, fostering a culture of diversity and inclusion. The Group shall maintain the highest safety
 standard and protect the health of our employees and others associated with our operations.
- Governance & Ethics: commitment to high ethical standards, compliance, and integrity, focusing on transparency. Our Ethical Principles put our Core Values—committed, safety conscious, creative, competent, and result-oriented—into practice. The Group maintain zero tolerance for corruption, enforce stringent policies for employees, contractors, and partners, and conduct human rights due diligence and responsible supply chain management.
